A YEAR OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

What the Saints had to say about the Eucharist

Who are the Saints? Throughout the New Testament, *saint* is used to refer to all who believed in Jesus Christ and who followed His teachings. Catholics also use the term to refer to especially holy men and women who, by persevering in the Christian Faith and living extraordinary lives of virtue, have already entered Heaven. The word *saint* comes from the Latin *sanctus* and literally means "holy." As we seek to understand the importance of the Mass in our lives, we can learn a lot on how powerful and life-giving the Mass was to all the Saints:

"There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." - *St. John Vianney*

"The celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross." - *St. Thomas Aquinas*

"When Mass is being celebrated, the sanctuary is filled with countless angels who adore the divine victim immolated on the altar." - *St. John Chrysostom*

"If we only knew how God regards this Sacrifice, we would risk our lives to be present at a single Mass." - *St. Padre Pio, stigmatic priest*

"Renew your faith by attending Holy Mass. Keep your mind focused on the mystery that is unfolding before your eyes. In your mind's eye transport yourself to Calvary and meditate on the Victim who offers Himself to Divine Justice, paying the price of your redemption." - *St. Padre Pio, stigmatic priest*
