‘Invite Lapsed Catholics’ Campaign

The Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate at Georgetown University says: *“It is estimated that only 23 percent of U.S. Catholics attend Mass each week. Those 77 percent absent from the Eucharistic Feast each week are not strangers: They are our parents, siblings, spouses, children and friends.”* The document further said: *“Most Catholics stop attending Mass because they have busy schedules or a lack of time, have family responsibilities, have health problems or disabilities, have conflicts with work, do not believe missing Mass is a sin or believe that they are not very religious people.”*

Some have drifted away because of one or another issue. Some feel alienated from the church because of the way they perceive the church or its teaching. Some have left because they were mistreated by church representatives.

If they are invited to return to the practice of their faith they may wonder and worry about the following:

Will the Mass be the same? Will I be judged because I stayed away so long? Maybe I have sinned so greatly that I cannot come back. What if I cannot remember the words to Mass?

By the same token, those who must do the inviting are often afraid of asking family members, friends or co-workers to come with them to Mass. And if they manage to do the invitation, they are afraid that they are ill equipped to explain the many steps, gestures and symbols of the Mass.

PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY—SEPT 21 AND 22

To show our appreciation to our priests here at St. John Vianney, we will be presenting Fr. Vincent Vu, Fr. Arnold Ortiz, and Fr. James Joseph, each with a "Spiritual Bouquet" which is a Catholic tradition that involves giving prayers or acts of devotion to someone else. Each priest will be given a poster card to show what the spiritual bouquet consists of, including the devotional act and the giver.

The spiritual bouquet poster card is our way of showing our priests that our community is praying for them. Welcome Someone Back.

- Don't be shy to reach-out and invite a non-practicing/inactive Catholic to return Home to the Catholic Church and resume active practice of their faith.
- Ask Jesus to guide you and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation with them. God knows exactly what this person needs to hear and will speak through you.
- Let them know you have missed them at church and that they have an important place in our parish family and that they are always welcome back.
- Inquire as to the reasons they have stopped attending Mass. Be sure to let them know that whatever the reason, you and our parish family are here to support them.
- Prepare for objections they may raise, but never argue or get defensive. Tell them that they are not alone and to not be afraid to find answers to their questions and concerns through our parish priest and community.
- Regardless of why they left or got out of the habit of going to Mass, let them know they can always come home to the practice of the sacraments and the fullness of a relationship with Jesus Christ and the Church he founded.
- Invite them to come with you to Mass not only at Christmas and Easter, but also for celebratory dates like birthdays, anniversaries, graduations or other milestones. Include a meal afterwards if needed to entice them.
- Offer to bring them to one of our parish events, such as Breakfast with the Bishop, Mardi Gras, Trunk or Treat, or Advent Wreath Making to help them return to the church.
- The most persuasive way to bring others back is our own personal belief in the beauty and wonder of the Mass and how it supports your relationship with God. Let your love for the Mass be contagious!
- Learn as much as possible about the Mass and the reasons we Catholics do the things we do. Be prepared to state what we personally know to be the truth.
- Share motivational websites on the Internet such as catholicscomehome.org. There are also many video presentations on the Mass that can be shared on sites like YouTube and Facebook.

Our Parish Faith Formation Committee encourages everyone in our parish family to learn more about this specific topic.

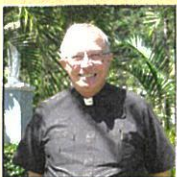
