This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday

The word "catechesis" means "to echo." Literally, we are to echo the good news of Jesus Christ to the world. This is not a suggestion; it is a command of our Lord. Some people are called and set apart in our communities as catechists - those formally trained and charged with passing on the Gospel to children and adults, both inside and outside of our communities. On Catechetical Sunday, we acknowledge them and remind ourselves of the need for formation and growth in all of us. To be a catechist is a privileged calling, and today be sure to say "thank you" to one in your community.

However, on this day, it would be wrong to only look to those bearing the title of a catechist for an echoing of good news. Parents are the first and primary catechists in a child's life. Even more, all of us are also important catechists in the lives of our coworkers, our spouses, our relatives, and our friends. We are ALL called to echo and share the Gospel message.

Some say catechesis begins in the home; however, it truly begins in the HEART. Our theme this year reflects our call to missionary discipleship. As St John Paul II reminded us: The universal call to holiness is closely linked to the universal call to mission. Every member of the faithful is called to holiness and to mission. We are called to be Eucharist by word and action to our brothers and sisters in Christ. Our times cry out for this kind of holiness, one inflamed by the ardent determination to bring as many of our brothers and sisters as possible to Christ. **Mahalo, catechists, teachers, and parish ohana!**

'Invite Lapsed Catholics' Campaign

According to statistics, there are about 67 million Catholics in the United States. Only about **32%** of those attend Mass weekly. That means that there are about 45 million Catholics who are at least mildly inactive. And half of those 45 million "rarely or never" attend Mass. How can you invite them? Here are some of the ways we can use to invite:

Pray: Before you invite your friend or family member back to Mass, spend time in prayer for that person and her or his family. Pray about the wounds that might be causing him or her to stay away. Reflect upon how much this person means to you and ask God to give you the right words and the right time to extend the invitation.

Be honest: Rather than listing all of the reasons why this person should come back to Mass, talk about how much you get out of going to Mass. Talk about how important your faith and Jesus are to you. For example, if you know that this person is spiritual, acknowledge this and bridge the conversation from their faith to Mass. You could say something like: *"My faith has held me together during the most important and difficult times of my life. You might find that same kind of support. Would you like to come to Mass with me?"*

Be specific: People who have been away from Mass for some time may not find it easy to start going back. Invite your friend to come with you. State when you are going, which parish you are going to, and what time you are going. Include an opportunity to socialize afterward and offer a ride if necessary. A simple example of an invitation would be as follows: *"Our family always looks forward to Sunday Mass. I remember going as a child and loving the music and the sense of hope all around me. Our family would love for you to come with us. You are welcome to come with us for lunch afterwards."*

Prayer devotion stickers include: *I have offered my Mass for you. I made a Holy Hour for you. I prayed a Divine Mercy chaplet for you. I prayed a Rosary for you. I prayed a novena for you. I prayed the Stations of the Cross for you. I prayed for you. I have performed an act of charity in your honor.* Please join us in this beautiful way to show our support and love for our priests on Priesthood Sunday.

Welcome Someone Back.

- Don't be shy to reach-out and invite a non-practicing/inactive Catholic to return Home to the Catholic Church and resume active practice of their faith.
- Ask Jesus to guide you and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation with them. God knows exactly what this person needs to hear and will speak through you.
- Let them know you have missed them at church and that they have an important place in our parish family and that they are always welcome back.
- Inquire as to the reasons they have stopped attending Mass. Be sure to let them know that whatever the reason, you and our parish family are here to support them.
- Prepare for objections they may raise, but never argue or get defensive. Tell them that they are not alone and to not be afraid to find answers to their questions and concerns through our parish priest and community.
- Regardless of why they left or got out of the habit of going to Mass, let them know they can always come home to the practice of the sacraments and the fullness of a relationship with Jesus Christ and the Church he founded.
- Invite them to come with you to Mass not only at Christmas and Easter, but also for celebratory dates like birthdays, anniversaries, graduations or other milestones. Include a meal afterwards if needed to entice them.
- Offer to bring them to one of our parish events, such as Breakfast with the Bishop, Mardi Gras, Trunk or Treat, or Advent Wreath Making to help them return to the church.
- The most persuasive way to bring others back is our own personal belief in the beauty and wonder of the Mass and how it supports your relationship with God. Let your love for the Mass be contagious!
- Learn as much as possible about the Mass and the reasons we Catholics do the things we do. Be prepared to state what we personally know to be the truth.
- Share motivational websites on the Internet such as catholicscomehome.org. There are also many video presentations on the Mass that can be shared on sites like YouTube and Facebook.

Our Parish Faith Formation Committee encourages everyone in our parish family to learn more about this specific topic.

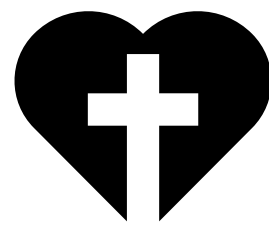

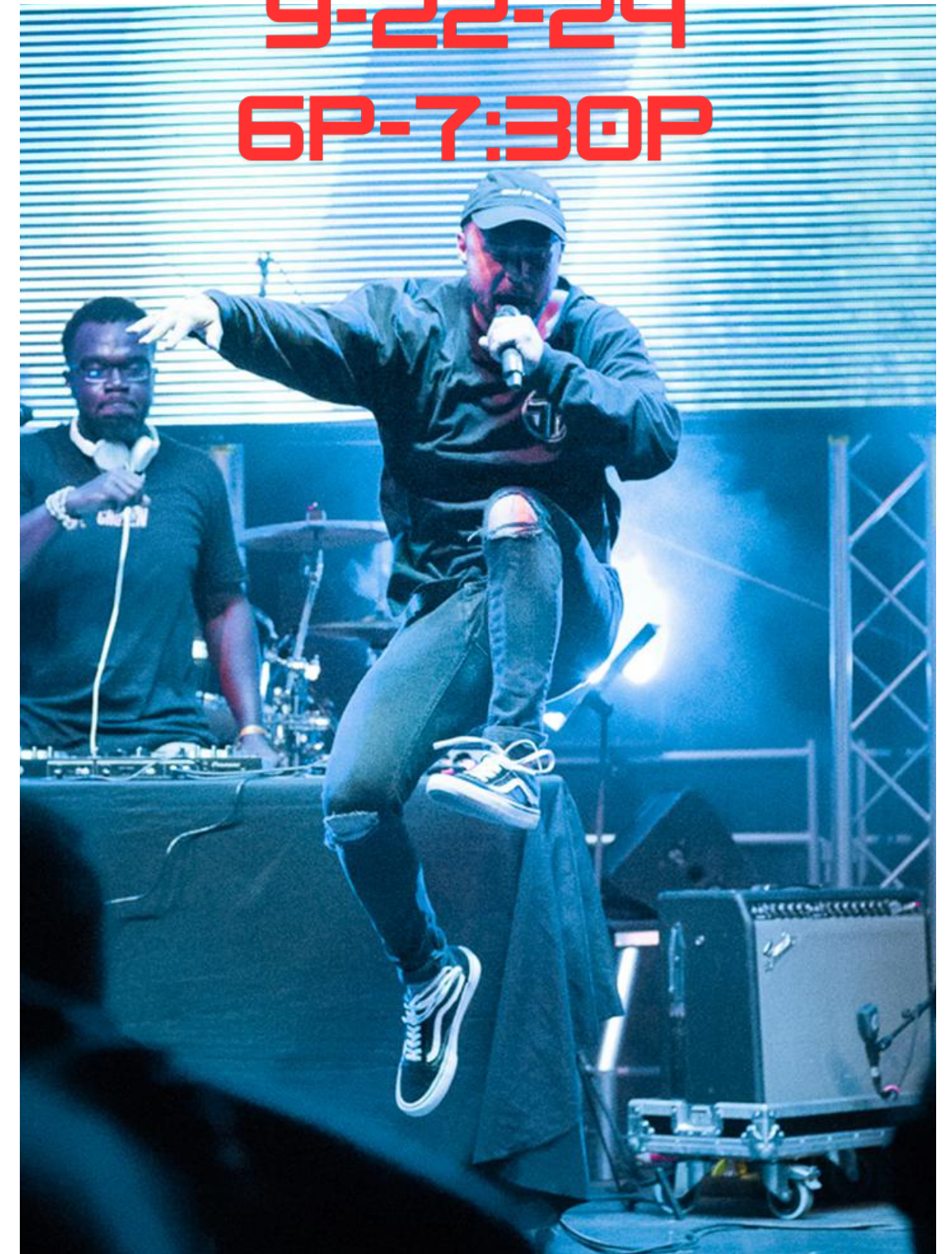
