

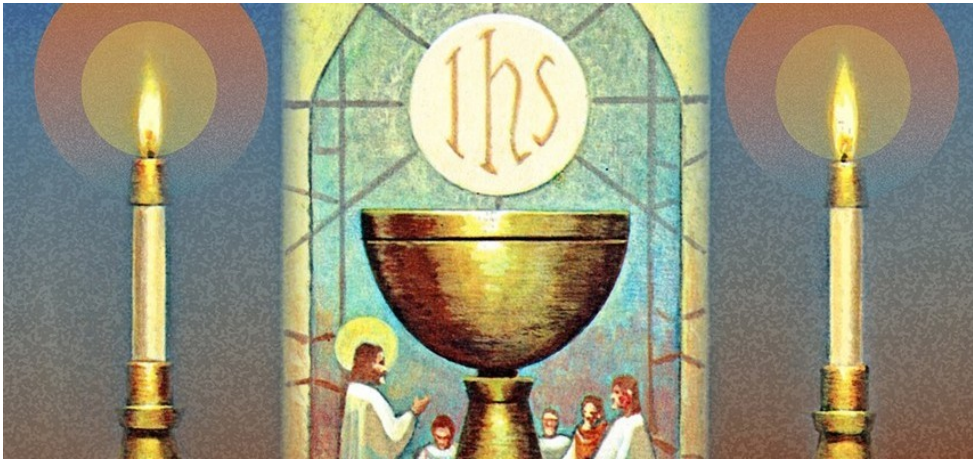

The Gift of Fortitude

Jesus' unwavering call to "love one another" and his love for outcasts, show how the Gift of Fortitude keeps the spiritual and ministerial gaze in the right place, no matter the distractions posed by society or those close to us. Through acts of Christ-like kindness and compassion, we benefit from the gift of fortitude to show society how to refocus.

As with any virtue that we desire to build; prayer, frequent reception of the sacraments, Eucharistic adoration and Mass attendance are crucial activities that keep us focused and faithful. Here, too, the gift of fortitude plays a key role, keeping us steady when we think we do not have enough time, a quiet place, or a coherent word to say to our Creator. And, as we strengthen ourselves in the virtue of fortitude, and witness God's amazing grace in our lives time and again, what might have begun as "I don't know how I'm going to get through this" moments, turn into "awe" at how greatly God supplied us with whatever we needed and more!

Writing to the Corinthians about a painful, ongoing affliction (2 Cor 12:7), the apostle Paul writes: *"Three times, I begged the Lord about this, that it might leave me, but he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness.' I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ may dwell with me. Therefore, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions and constraints, for the sake of Christ; for when I am weak, then I am strong"* (2 Cor 12:8-10).

A blessed reminder that as we face adversity of any kind in faith and prayer, we are not alone. God's grace and strength, through the gift of fortitude, are present even in our weakest moments.
