More than 35 Faith Action members and supporters joined the 4:00-5:00 PM Climate Vigil at the state Capitol on Dec. 17.

The enthusiastic group heard a song by Devan Chang, a prayer by Rev. T.J. FitzGerald (minister of First Unitarian Church of Honolulu), a reading by Environmental Justice task force chair Susan Gorman-Chang, and a call to action by FA president Ikaika Hussey.

The group held up posters, banners, and a Christmas star lantern that reminded passersby of the need for all to protect God's creation, the aina, and all creatures that keep the web of life intact.
