SCHOOL NEWS

This year St. John Vianney School is celebrating 59 years of providing an outstanding Catholic education to children in a nurturing environment. CATHOLIC FAITH

Concluding our 5-week series on the Bread of Life discourse, we read in John 6:60–61 “This saying is hard; who can accept it?”

And in John 6:67–69 “Jesus then said to the Twelve, ‘Do you also want to leave?’ Simon Peter answered him, ‘Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.’”

Jesus doesn’t back down on his teaching regarding the Real Presence, which invites us to respond with faith in him and his True Presence in the Eucharist. Faithful married love helps us better grasp Christ’s love for the Church and his love for each one of us, shown to us on the Cross, at Mass, and in the Eucharist. Faithful witnesses and models encourage us and show us how to trust in Christ and his love for us.

REFLECTION QUESTION(S)

1. What is the place of good leaders like Peter in modeling our faith in the Eucharist? How can we encourage our leaders to be strong witnesses?
2. How are the union of spouses, the union of Christ and the Church, and union with Christ in Communion related to each other? How does that inform our understanding of the Eucharist?
3. What are the challenges to believing Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist and in trusting in his words and promises to us? Why are his words a “hard saying?” How can we make St. Peter’s statement of faith our own?

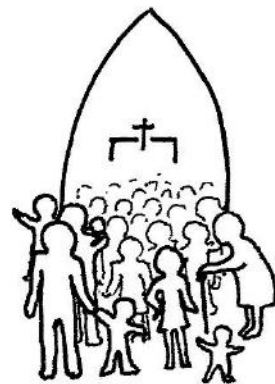

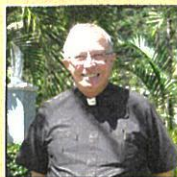

Invite One Back to the Church.

- There are many reasons why Catholics have stopped attending Mass, including a significant number who lost connection with our parish during the pandemic shutdowns, and just never came back.
- There is also a very real pain for grandparents, parents, and children who have witnessed their loved ones who no longer practice the Catholic faith.
- We need to respond to the Holy Spirit's promptings to "Invite Back" those who have been away from the regular practice of the Mass. Let us pray earnestly for the Holy Spirit's guidance and fortitude to carry out this sacred mission.
- Each of us needs to invite back someone who has left the Church in a way that makes them feel seen and desired as a member of our parish family.
- The majority will only come back if personally invited. An invitation is not forceful nor aggressive, yet, by nature, it expects a response.
- It is important to invite these people back because it is a great act of love! It is also one of the simplest and most effective ways to evangelize.
- With the Invite One Back campaign, you are asked to identify a parishioner who hasn't returned to our parish since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic and to invite them back to Mass.
- Just like the Good Shepherd, we will call each of the lost sheep home as a part of the Invite One Back initiative.
- If even one person is missing from our parish, their absence matters! Every person who has ever been a parishioner at our church is a person with an immortal soul and, therefore, an infinite amount of value.
- The Church remains a spiritual home and community of people in need of God's love and mercy.
- May we embrace each soul with open arms, rejoicing as they return to the embrace of the Church and our parish community through the gift of the Eucharist.
