2024 Holy Days of Obligation in the Diocese of Honolulu

- ◆ Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a Patronal Feast day of the United States of America and is transferred to Monday, December 9 this year. (See the Sep. 26, 2024 Decree from the Ofc. of the Bishop.) Holy Day Masses at 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- ◆ Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord (also known as the “Christ Mass”). Masses on December 24 at 5 p.m. and 8 p.m. and on December 25 at 9 a.m.

Advent Communal Penance Services in the Windward Vicariate

Advent has a twofold character: as a season to prepare for Christmas when Christ's first coming to us is remembered, and as a season that directs the mind and heart to await Christ's second coming at the end of time. Thus, Advent is a period for devout and joyful expectation, and the Sacrament of Penance is a means of deepening conversion to receive both comings of Christ. Year of Mission: Sharing with others My Relationship with Jesus

Last Sunday we saw how bringing people to church to hear about Jesus is one way of sharing Jesus. However, bringing the church to the people in creative ways, is another way of spreading the hope of Christ with the world. We took a close look at how effective it is to have more conversations and fewer confrontations. Here is a way to get you inspired to share Jesus more often.

Being an Inviting Person is More Important than being a Convincing Person:

Being convincing is a good thing. For some reason, we have bought into the idea that it is ultimately our job to convince people that they need Jesus, yet at the same time we are unwilling to share with them why we need Him. They could easily perceive this as inauthentic, even rude or judgmental. Too much of our confidence could be perceived as arrogance to an outsider to the faith.

But what if evangelism really is more about sharing than convincing? More about being vulnerable with our brokenness than being so quick to point it out in others? When you are willing, in humility to first share with someone about your brokenness, your heart idols, and your own need for Jesus, they are much more likely to be drawn into a conversation, than if you just start the conversation by asking them why they should be allowed into heaven one day. We want to give people space to put their guard down for a few minutes, not provoke them to put it up. We want to give them space to hear about Jesus. Grace is inviting, not imposing. Grace and truth go together (John 1:17). So let grace lead the way, and truth will back you up when necessary.

RITE OF ENROLLMENT FOR CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES

On December 7th at the 5 p.m. Mass, this year's Confirmation candidates will participate in a Rite of Enrollment ceremony. It marks the "journey of faith" for children and their parents who are in the sacramental formation process. It is a sign to us as a parish community that we all have a role in the faith formation of anyone in our parish. It also shows children and their families that they are part of the larger faith community, as members of our parish community provide prayer and support which is needed for the children, their families, and their catechist throughout the formation period. Some of the students will also experience their first reconciliation, and on their confirmation day receive their first Holy Communion as part of our parish's restored order of sacraments.

We ask that you keep in your prayers the 2025 Confirmation candidates, and also that you commitment to pray for them weekly. If fully prepared, they will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in May of 2025 with Bishop Larry Silva.

During this Holiday Season Encourage Someone To Return to Sunday Mass.

- Everyone knows someone who comes to Mass only at Christmas and Easter. This Holiday season be sure to encourage them to attend Sunday Mass.
- It is a tremendous gift to help a friend or family member return to Sunday Mass and experience God's grace and abundant blessings and worship God together.
- Write down a list of people you know and pray over the list, and ask the Holy Spirit to show you whom to reach out to. Pray for the graces necessary to follow through on helping them return to Sunday Mass.
- Share with this person how much you love him or her, and miss them at Mass on Sunday.
- Rather than listing all of the reasons why this person should come back to Mass on Sundays, talk about how much you get out of going to Mass. Fill in the blank; "The reason I love going to Sunday Mass is . . ." or "During Sunday Mass I really look forward to . . ."
- By attending Mass on Sunday, one acknowledges the importance of the Lord's Day, and as a Catholic fulfills God's law to "Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day."
- The first and foremost reason to attend Sunday Mass, is to receive the Eucharist, which is truly the body and blood of Jesus, who said "Do this in remembrance of me."
- Going to Sunday Mass to hear God's Word, and the opportunity for prayer, rest and renewal is what we all so desperately need for the health of our souls and minds.
- Sunday Mass offers a unique opportunity to encounter God that is not available anywhere else, and presents a profound encounter with God's mercy and forgiveness.
- Encourage them to come with you and your family, or with a group of friends, to Mass on Sunday and perhaps invite them to lunch afterwards.
- It is important to recognize that this may not be a "one and done" conversation but is more likely to be a series of conversations and invitations.

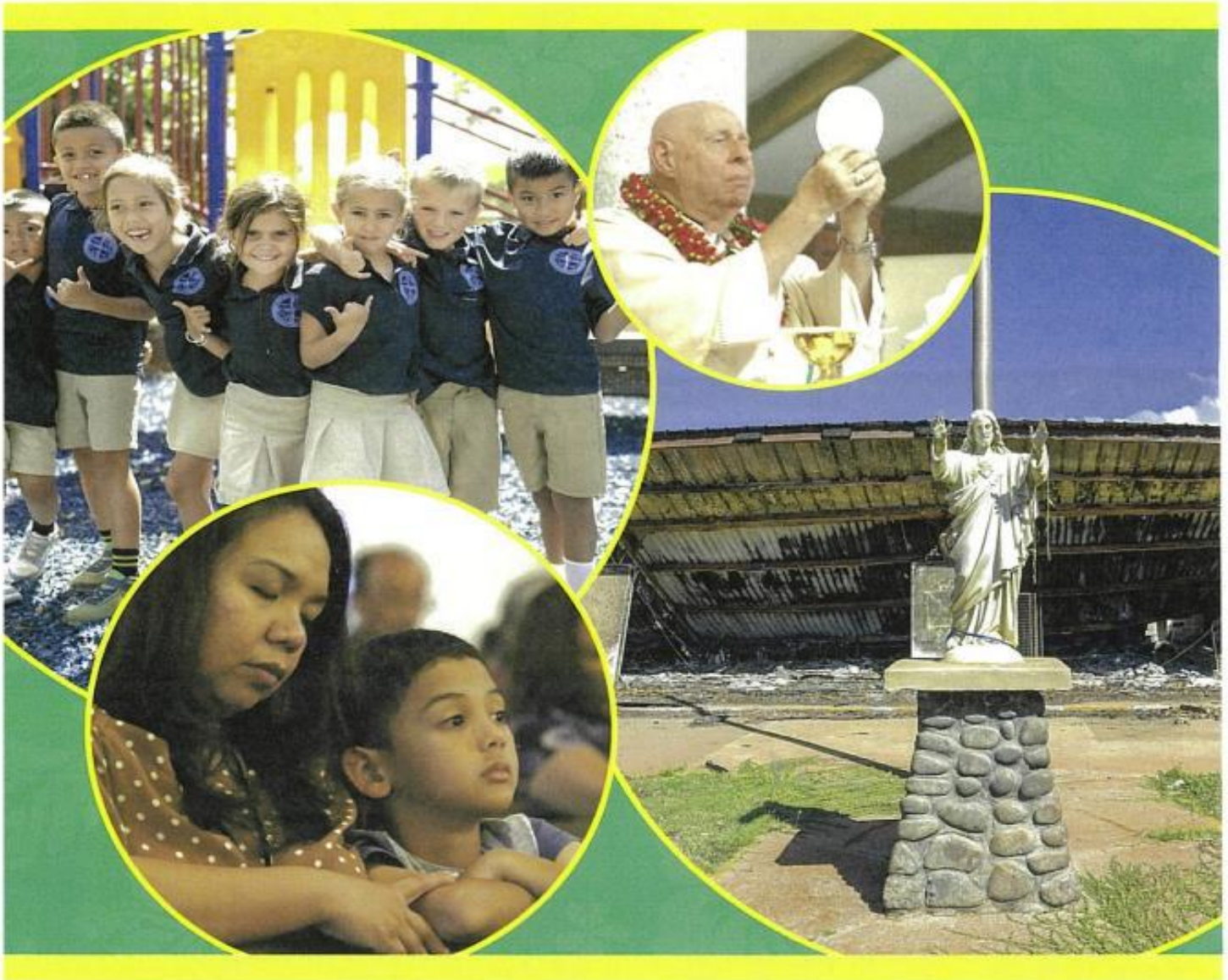

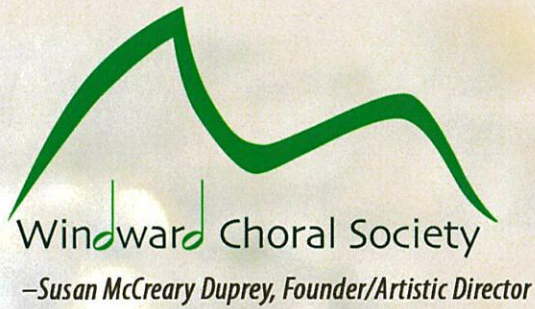
